- The Board of Elections does not provide legal advice; a candidate is solely responsible for ensuring that their own petition satisfies the requirements of law. Candidates are obligated to investigate, learn, and know the law governing the election process.
- The "Declaration of Candidacy" (party petition) or "Statement of Candidacy" (nonpartisan petition) AND "Nominating Petition" portion of each part petition must be fully completed and signed by the candidate(s) before being circulated. (R.C. 3513.07, 3513.261)
- Ohio law does not permit any corrections or additions to the petition once it is filed with the BOE. Petition Pre-checks are prohibited.
