
Official Election Results for the September 10, 2019 Primary Election are attached to the Election Summary Report. -

There were a total of 4,753 ballots tabulated for the September 10, 2019 Primary Election. Below is a breakdown of the ballots counted by category and a percentage of the total vote by category.
