FINAL RESULTS

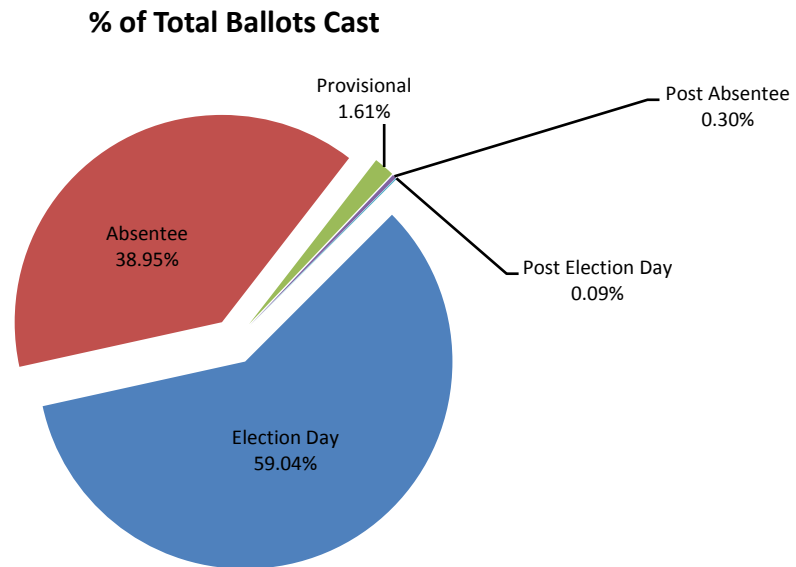
Official Election Results for the March 6, 2012 Primary Election are attached in the "Election Summary" report.

NOTE: There are forty-five (45) contests within districts overlapping eleven (11) surrounding counties. Cuyahoga County is the most populous county in forty-four (44) of those contests. Those overlapping county results are also attached.

SUMMARY OF OFFICIAL CANVASS

There were a total of 244,712 ballots tabulated for the March 6, 2012 Primary Election. Below is a breakdown of the ballots counted by category and a percentage of the total vote by category.

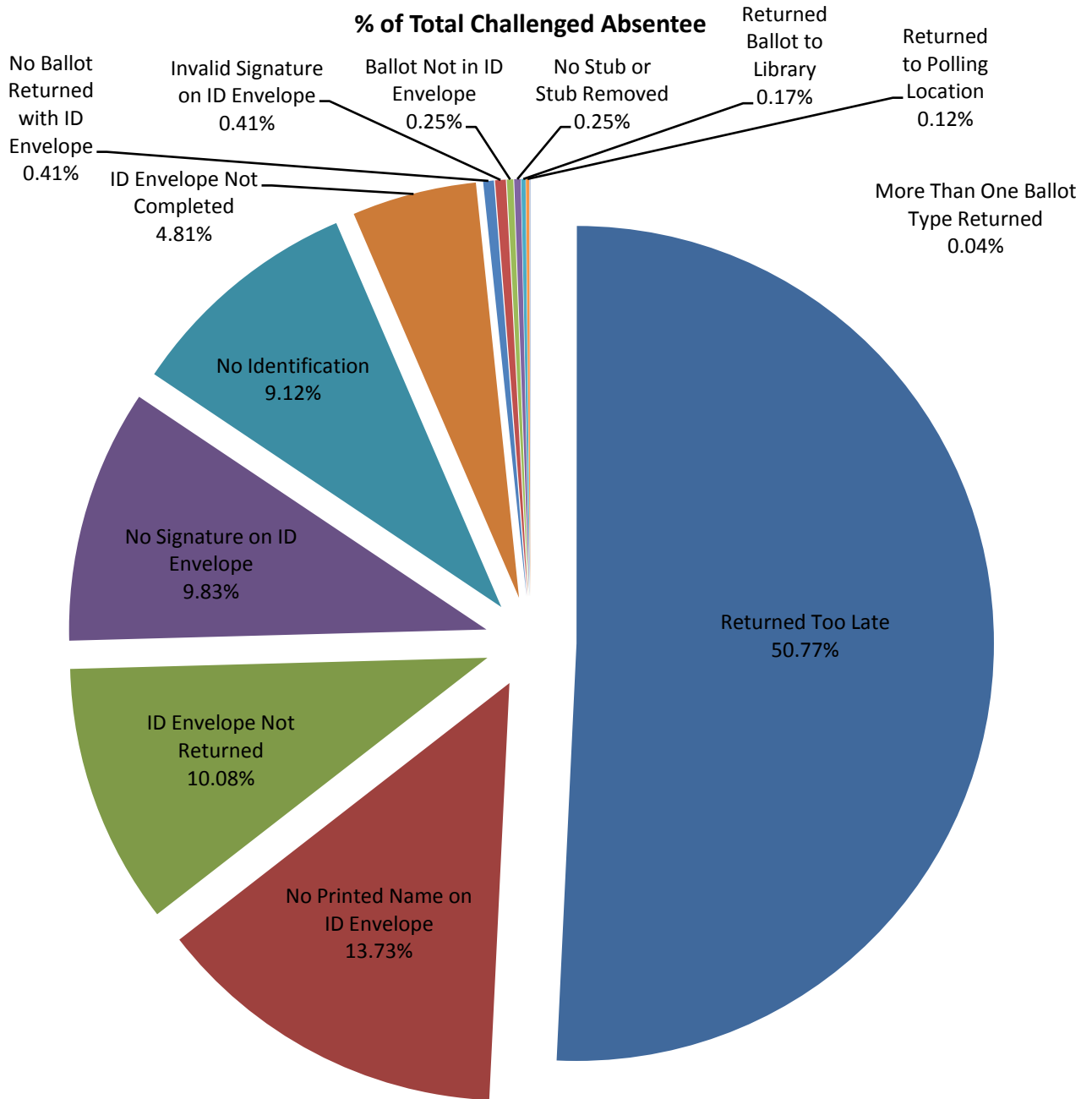
ABSENTEE / VOTE BY MAIL

The Cuyahoga County Board of Elections received a total of 113,386 valid Absentee/Vote by Mail applications. Of those requests, 98,474 ballots were returned (86.85%). The Ballot Department tabulated 96,063 Absentee / Vote by Mail Ballots (84.72%). There were 2,411 ballots challenged in this election resulting in a challenge rate of 2.45%*. Details of the challenges are below.

*The Absentee Ballot Challenge Rate is 1.22% when the Absentee Ballots postmarked after the deadline are excluded.

PROVISIONAL VOTING SUMMARY

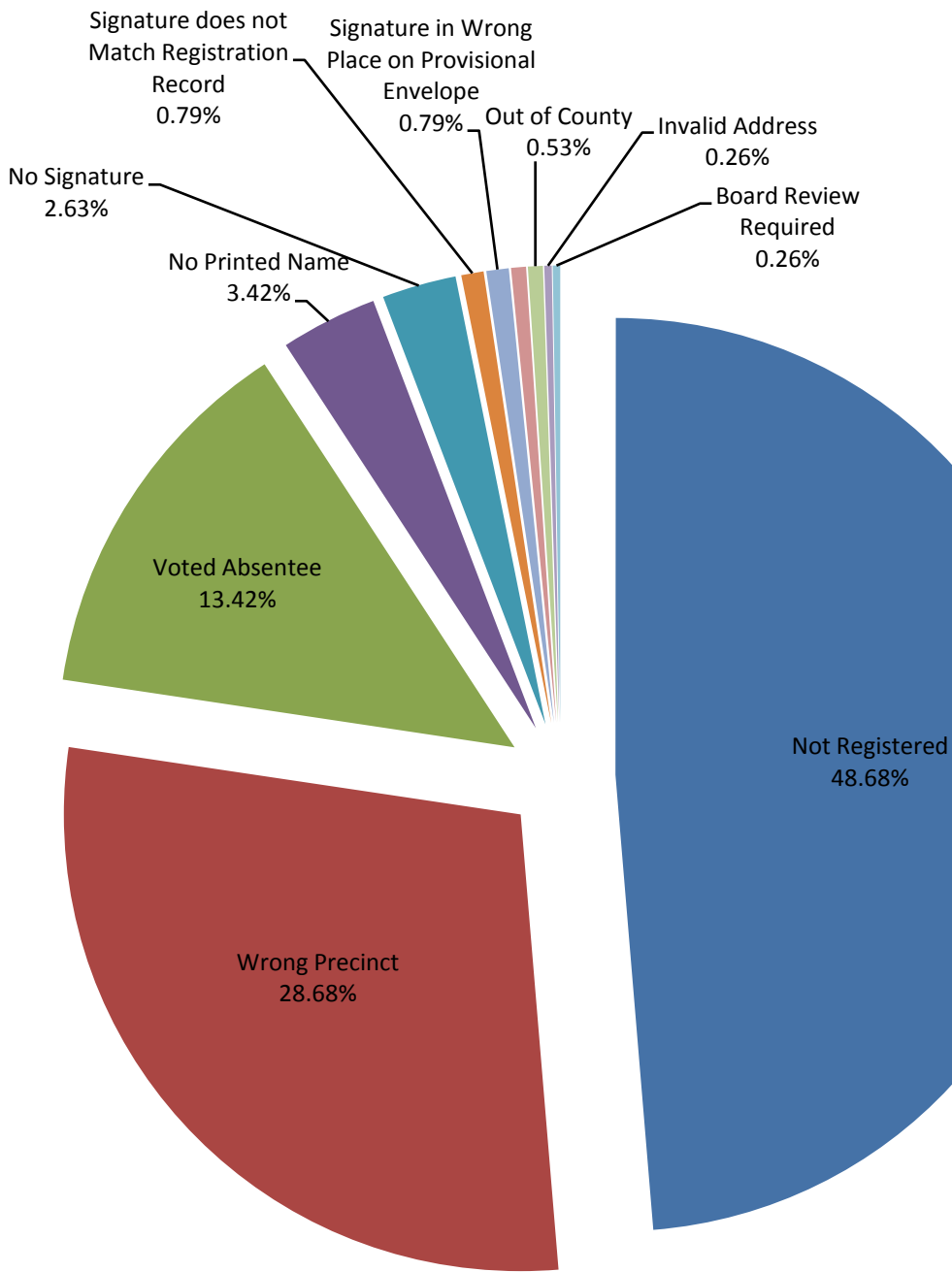
A total of 4,327 Provisional Ballots were cast In-House and on Election Day. Of those ballots, 3,947 (91.22%) were valid and tabulated by the Ballot Department. There were 380 invalid Provisional Ballots resulting in a 8.78%* rejection rate for this election. Details of the rejections are below.

* The Provisional Ballot Rejection Rate is 7.69% when Provisional Voters who have already cast an Absentee Ballot are excluded.

BALLOT REMAKES

During the election, 1,620 ballot pages were processed in accordance with the CCBOE Remake Policy (approved by the Board on February 7, 2012). Of those, 1,392 ballot pages were processed during the Unofficial Canvass; the remaining 397 were processed during the Official Canvass. The following is a breakdown by category:

OVER VOTES

There were a total of 4,911 over votes recorded, resulting in a 0.19% over vote rate for the election. The exact number of over voted ballots is unknown as the Unity system reports over votes on a per-contest basis, thus a ballot containing multiple over votes is recorded multiple times. A detailed listing of over votes cast by contest is attached.

POLL BOOK JUSTIFICATION AND BALLOT RECONCILIATION

All 1,063 precincts were involved in this election. The number of signatures in the Poll Books matches the number of Ballots Cast in 886 (83.34%) precincts. Below is a breakdown of the range of discrepancies between the number of signatures in the poll books and the number of ballots cast on Election Day.

RECOUNTS

One contest resulted in a margin of victory that is less than one half of one percent - the threshold to conduct an automatic recount.

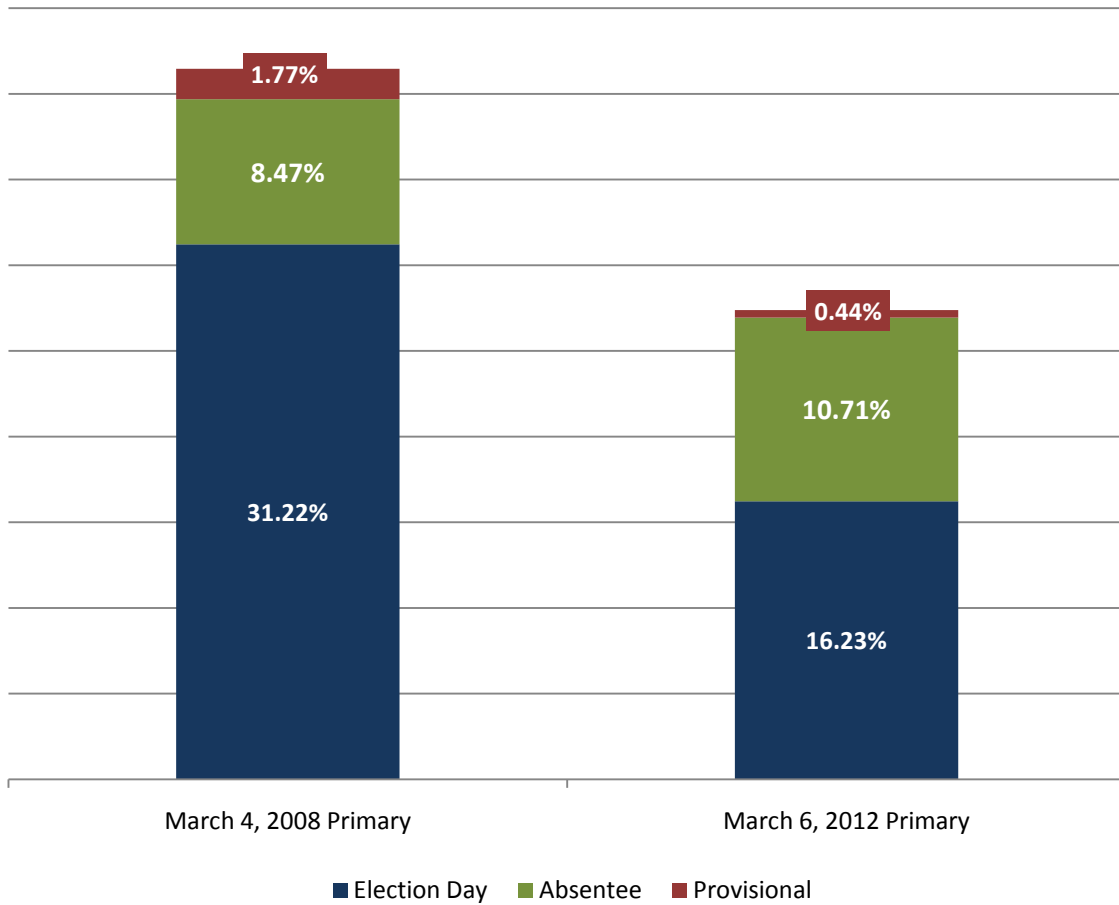
The schedule for the above automatic recount will be posted to our website by the close of business Tuesday, March 27, 2012. All involved candidates or issue committees will be notified via certified mail.

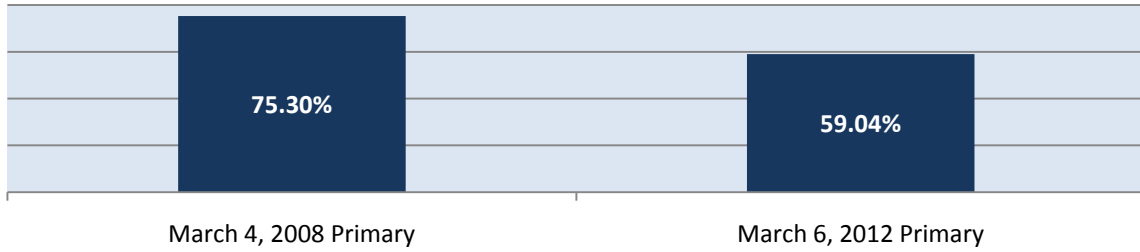

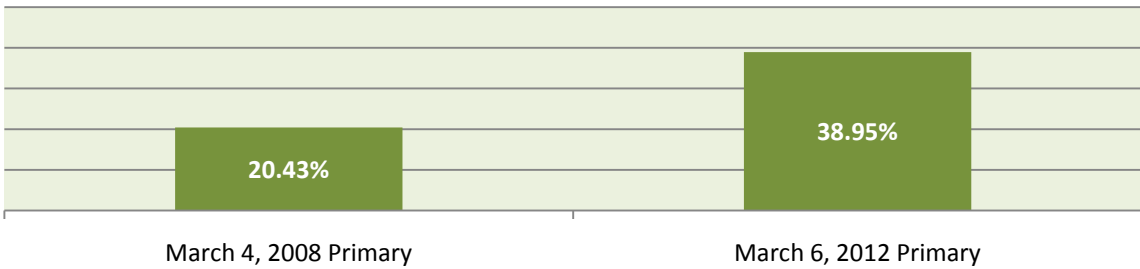

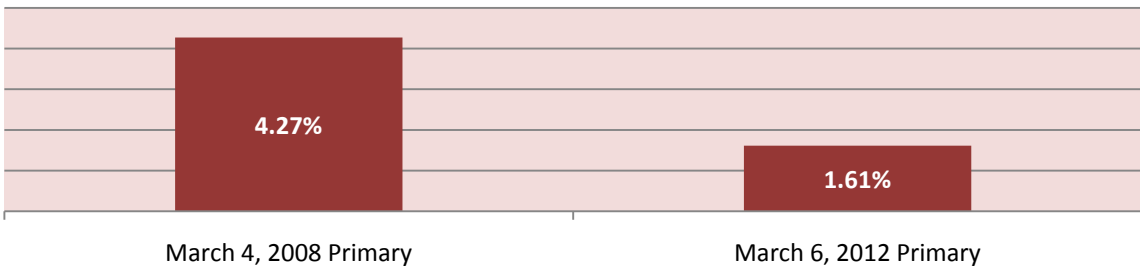
Election Day Voting Trend



Absentee Voting Trend



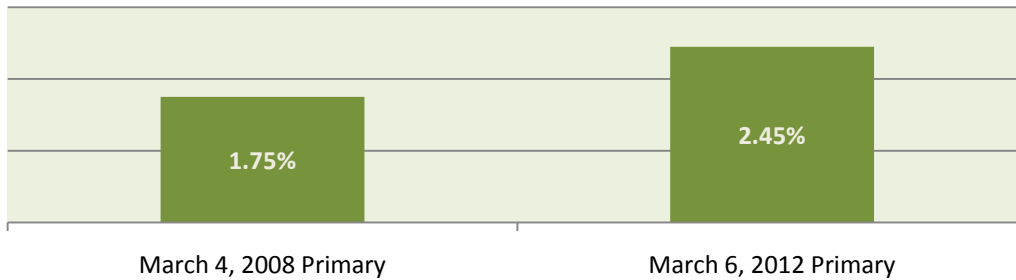
Provisional Voting Trend



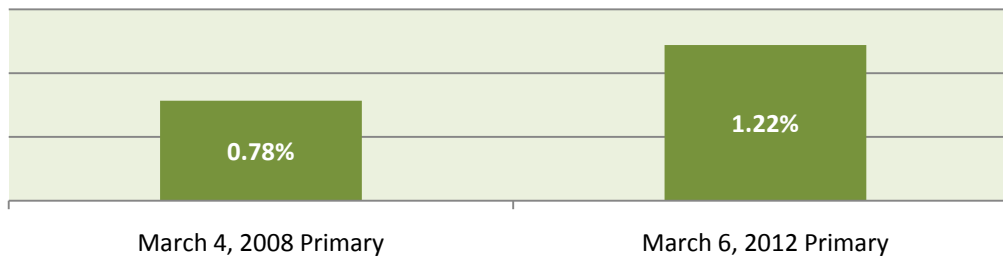

Challenge Rate



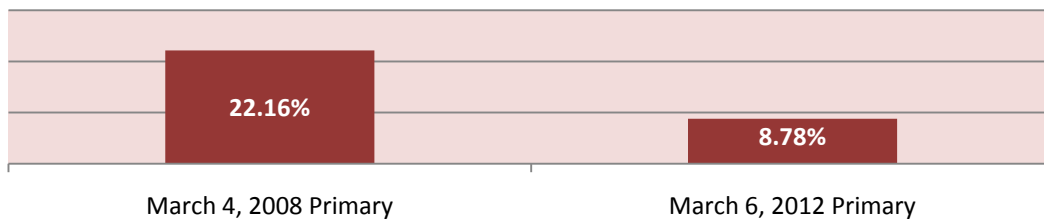
Challenge Rate (Excluding Late)



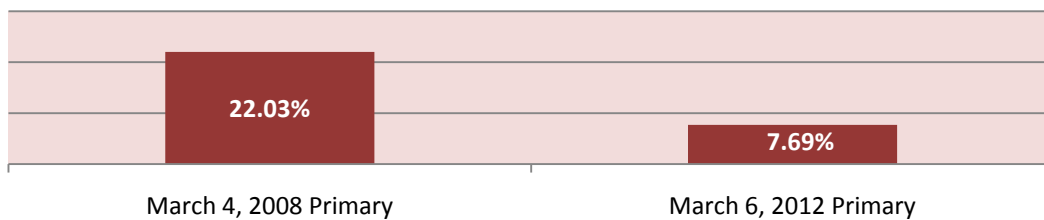

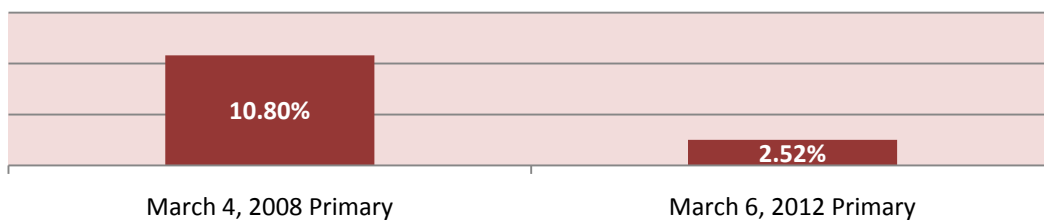
Rejection Rate
