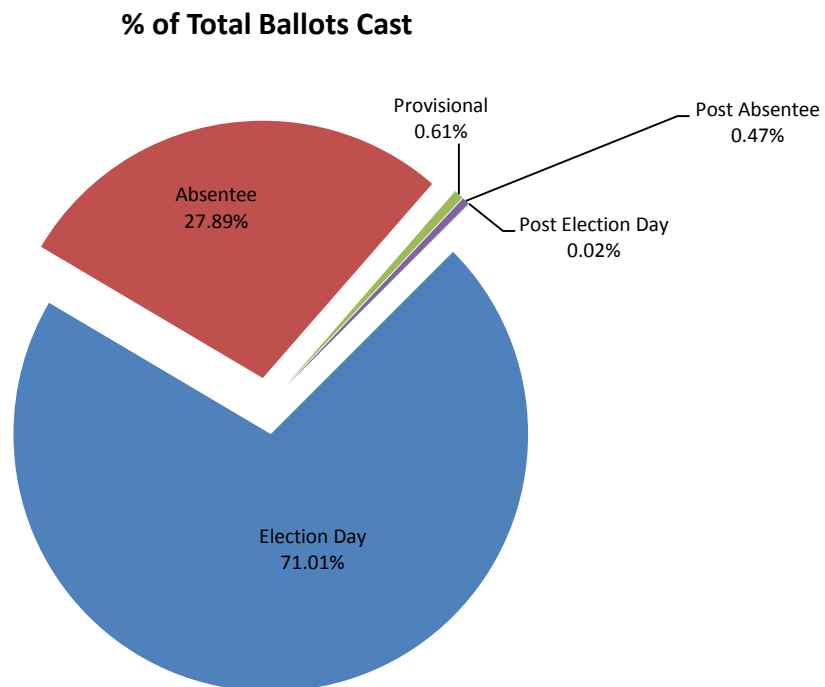
FINAL RESULTS

Official Election Results for the August 5, 2014 Special Election are attached in the Election Summary Report.

SUMMARY OF OFFICIAL CANVASS

There were a total of 6,403 ballots tabulated for the August 5, 2014 Special Election. Below is a breakdown of the ballots counted by category and a percentage of the total vote by category.

ABSENTEE / VOTE BY MAIL

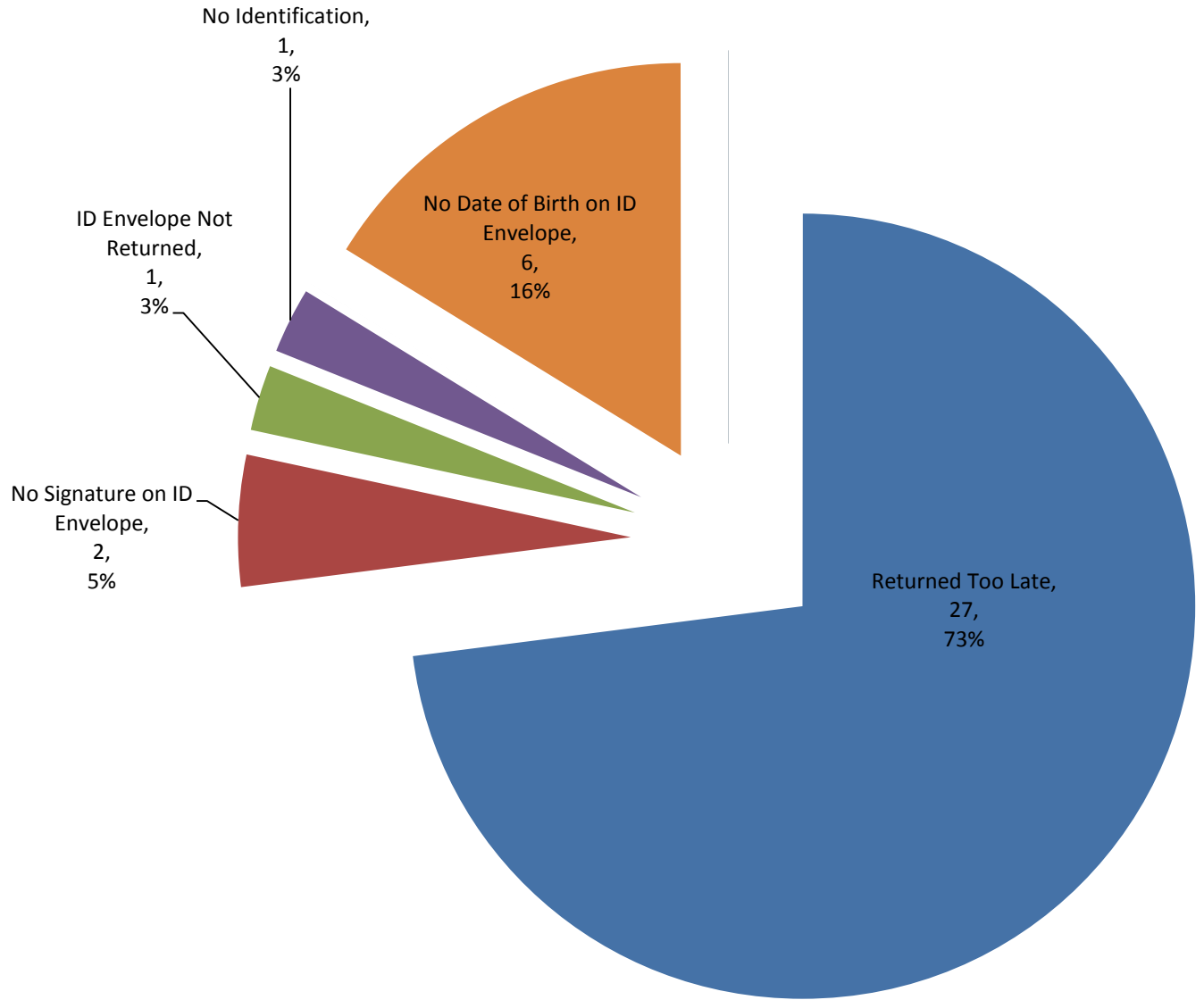
The Cuyahoga County Board of Elections received a total of 1,976 valid Absentee/Vote by Mail applications. Of those requests, 1,853 ballots were returned (93.78%). The Ballot Department tabulated 1,816 Absentee / Vote by Mail Ballots of the applications processed. There were 37 ballots challenged in this election resulting in a challenge rate of 2.00%*. Details of the challenges are below.

*The Absentee Ballot Challenge Rate is 0.55% when the Absentee Ballots postmarked after the deadline are excluded.

PROVISIONAL VOTING SUMMARY

A total of 45 Provisional Ballots were cast In-House and on Election Day. Of those ballots, 39 (86.67%) were valid and tabulated by the Ballot Department. There were 6 invalid Provisional Ballots resulting in a 13.33%* rejection rate for this election. Details of the rejections are below.

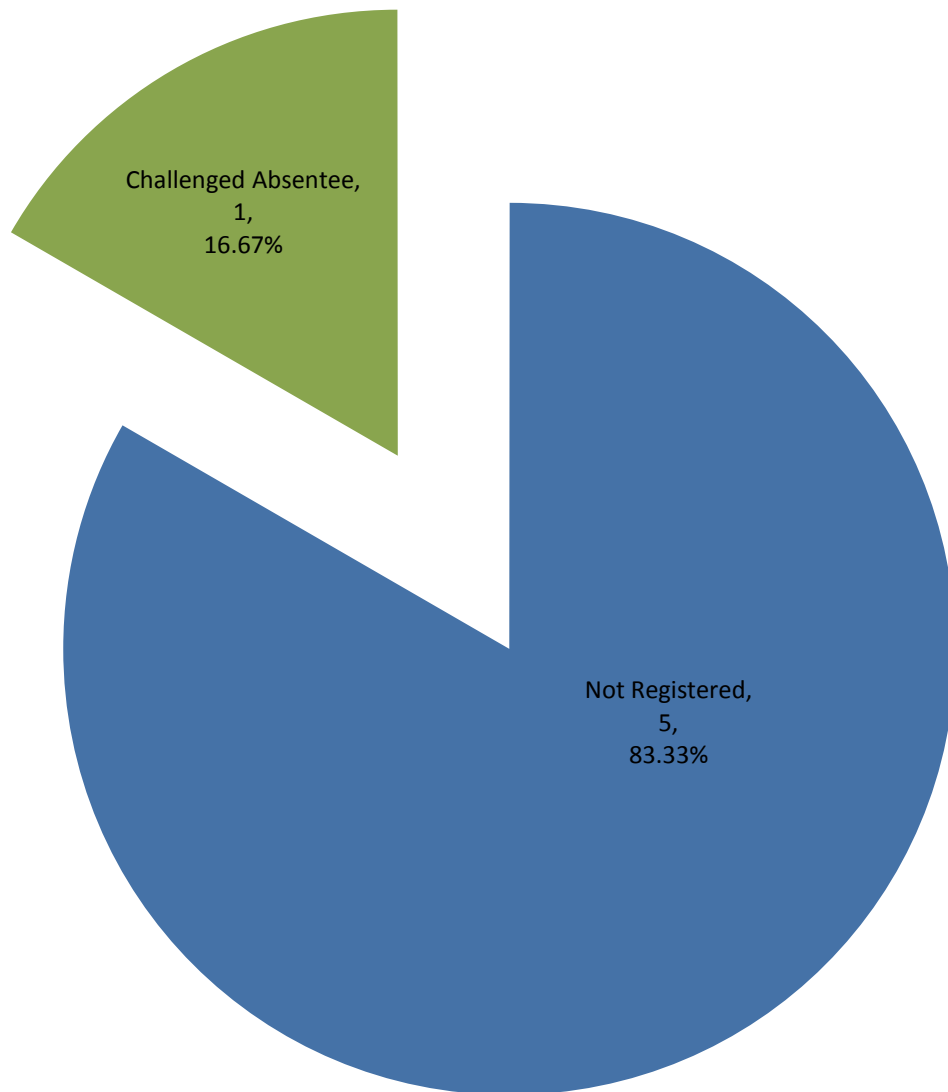

BALLOT REMAKES

During the election, 11 ballot pages were processed in accordance with the CCBOE Remake Policy (approved by the Board on May 17, 2013). Of those, 8 were processed during the Unofficial Canvass. The remaining 3 ballot pages were processed during the Official Canvass. The following is a breakdown by category:

VOTER HISTORY /BALLOT RECONCILIATION

AUDIT

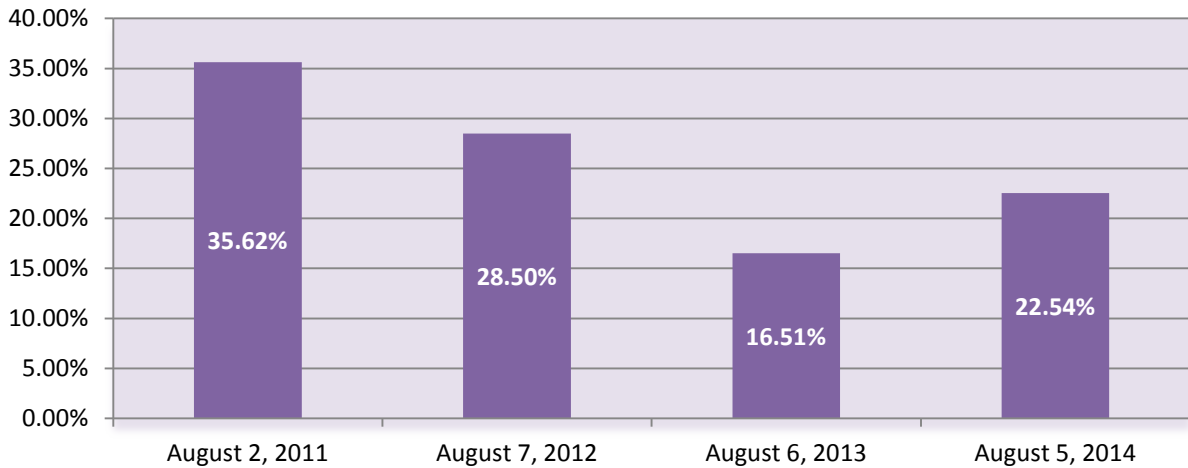
The post-election audit will begin on Thursday, September 4, 2014 at 9:30 AM. This audit will be conducted using the precinct batch based risk limiting audit method. The Board will randomly select the contest in which the audit will be conducted. If a requested recount is required, the recount will be performed instead of the audit.

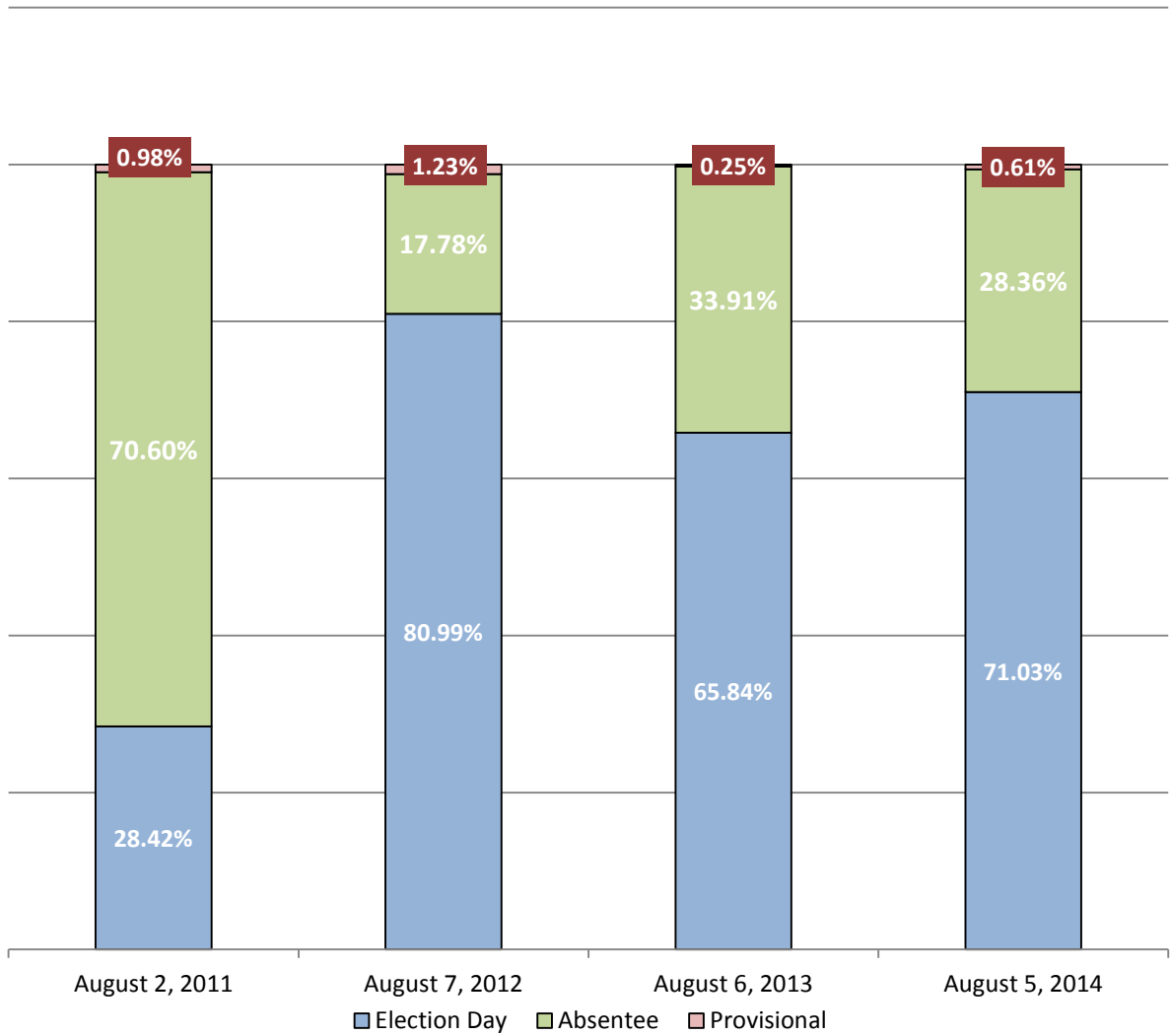




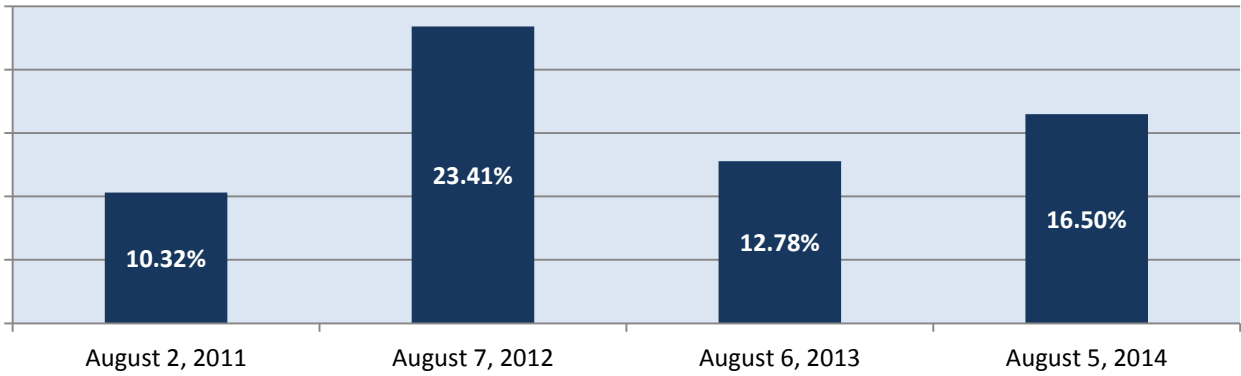

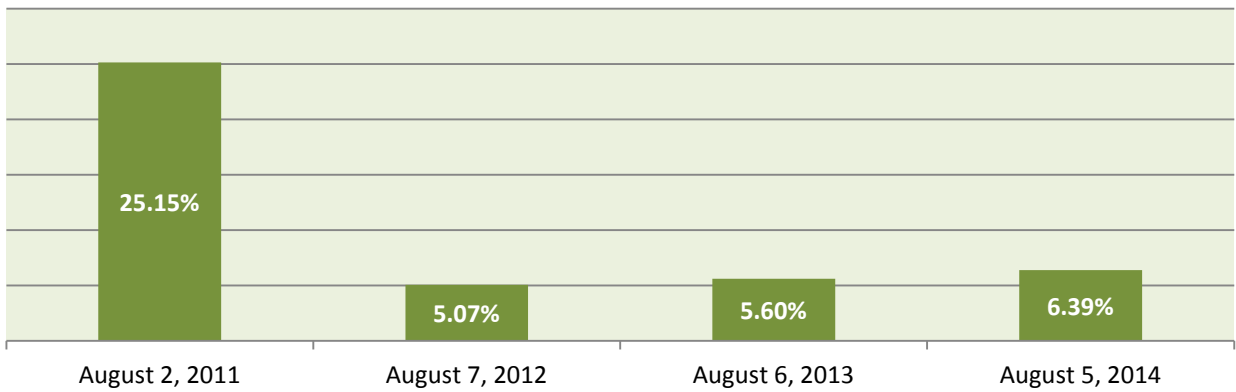
Voter Turnout by Category



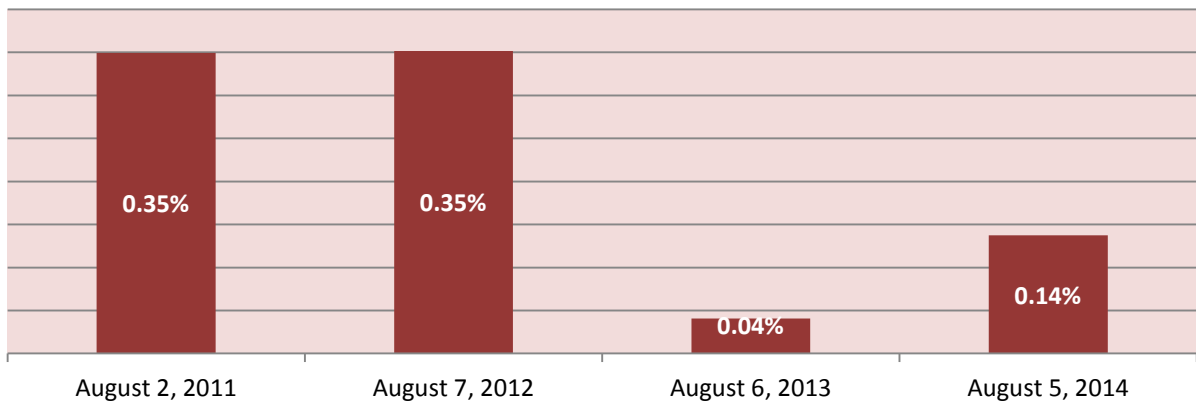
Election Day Voting Trend



Absentee Voting Trend



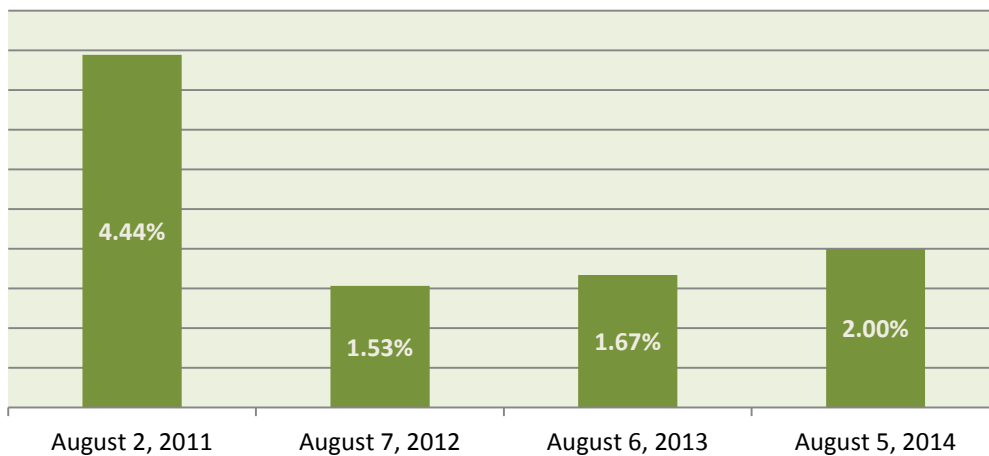
Provisional Voting Trend



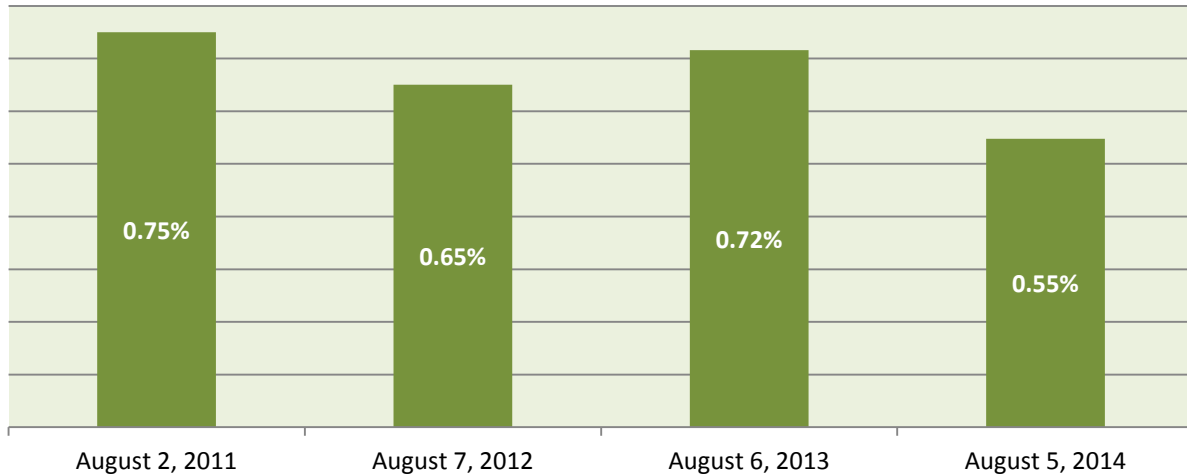

Challenge Rate (Excluding Late)

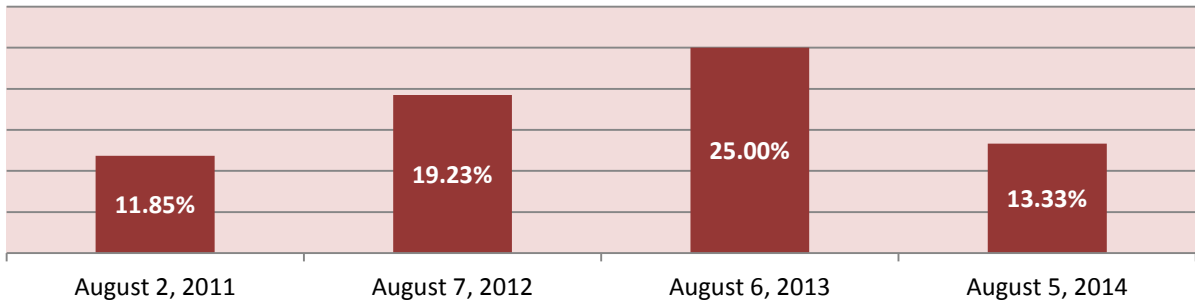

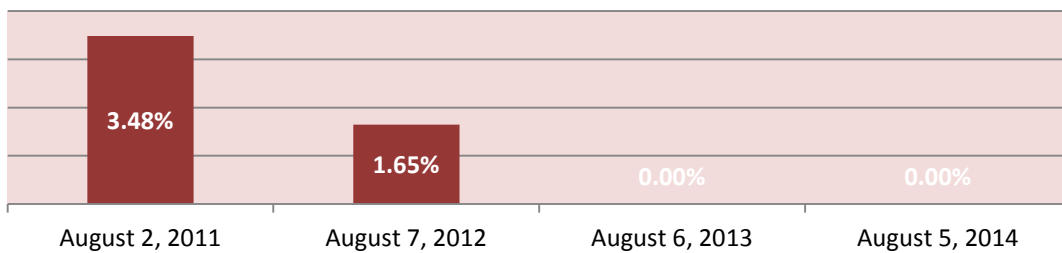

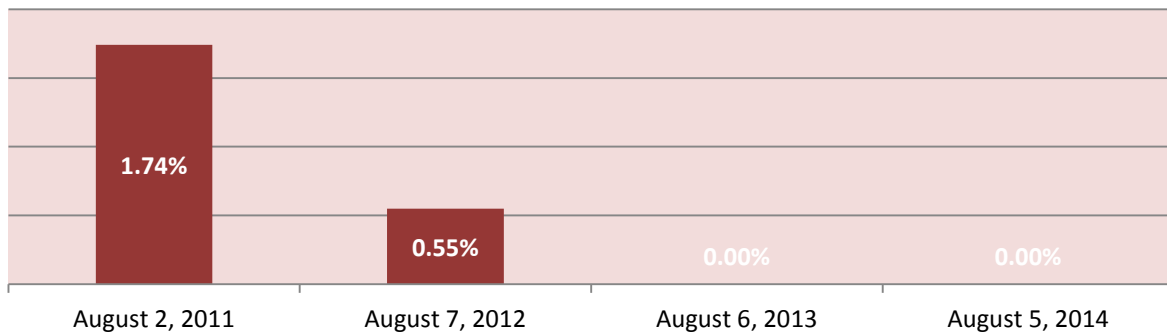
Rejection Rate
