**Voter Registration for November 6, 2012**



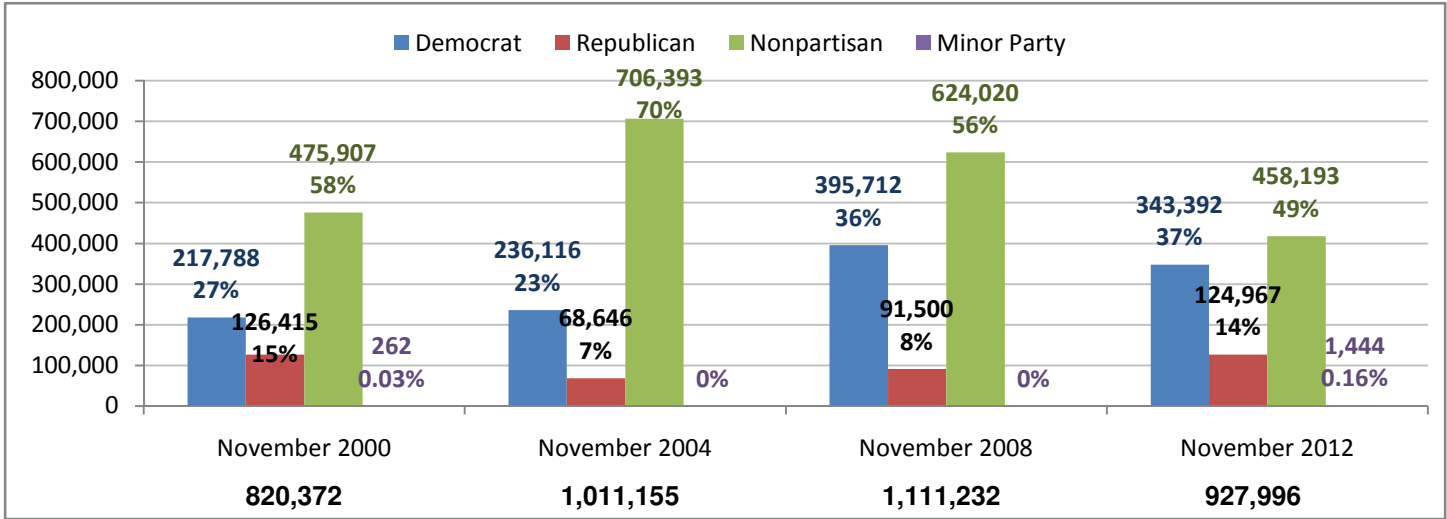

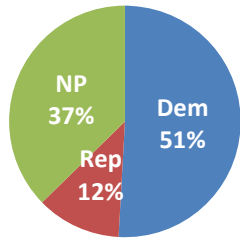

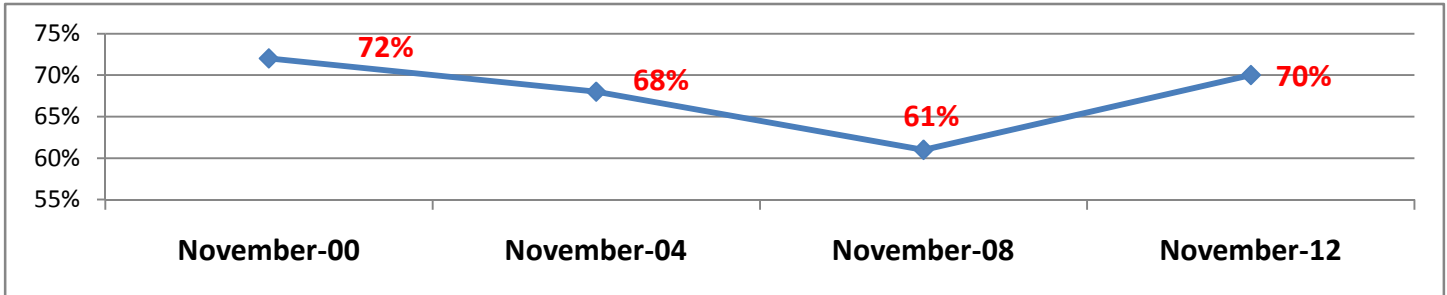

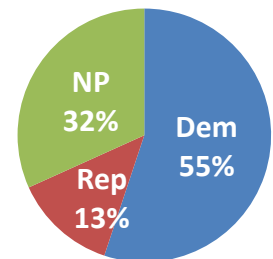

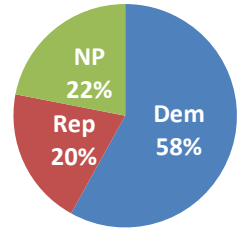

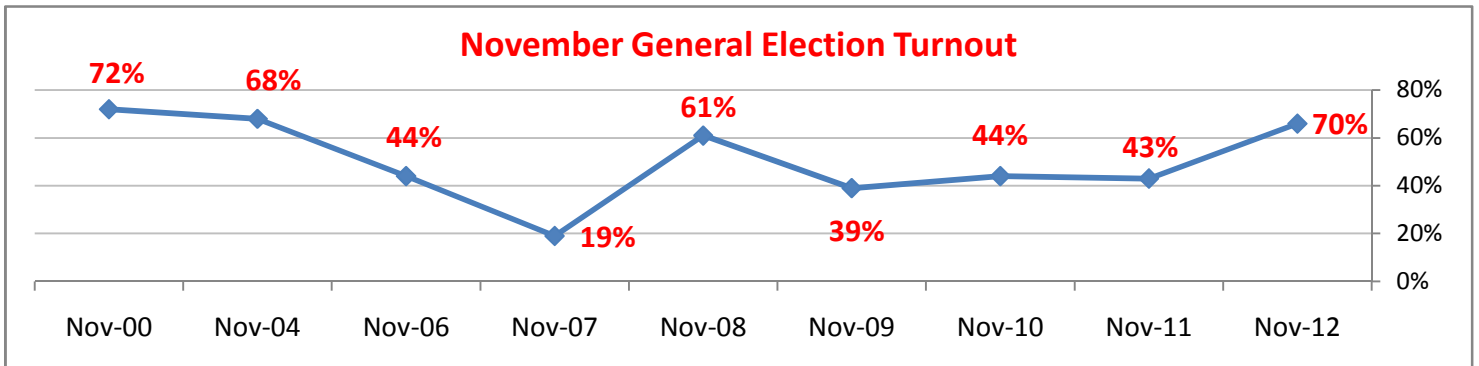

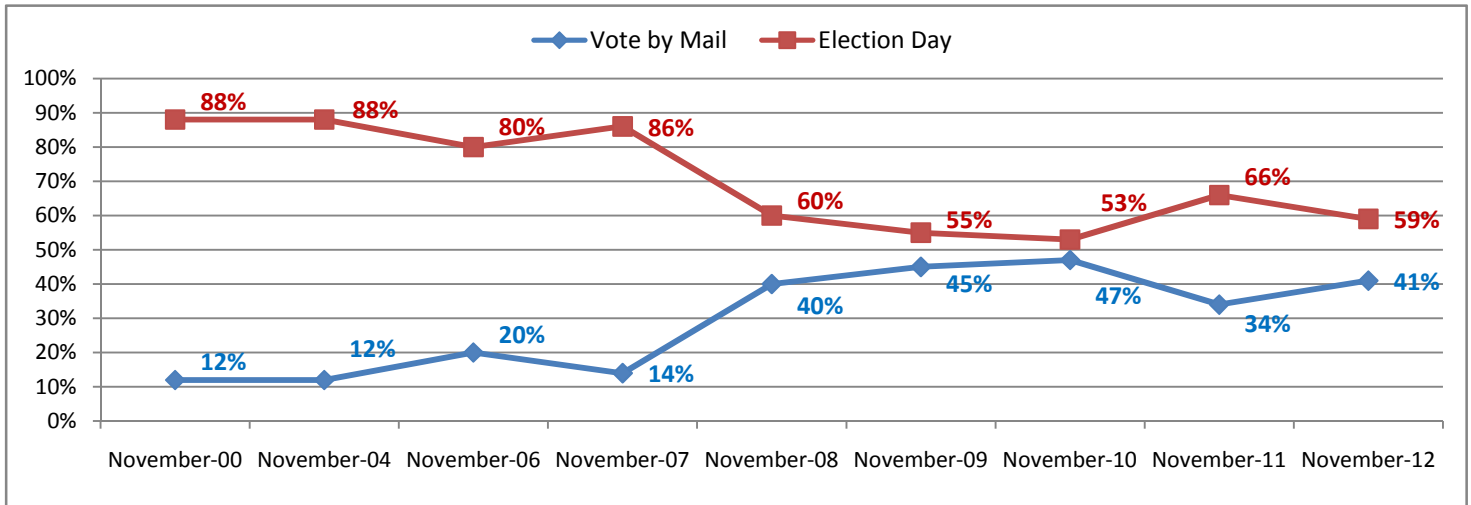

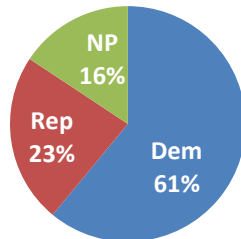

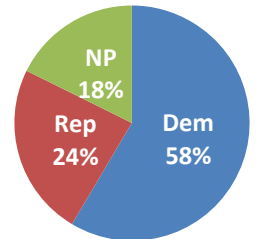

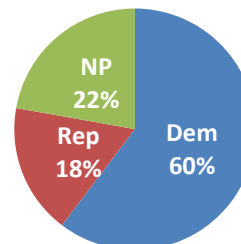

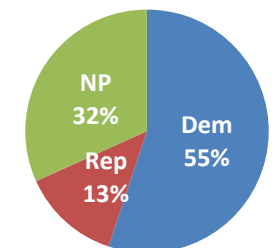

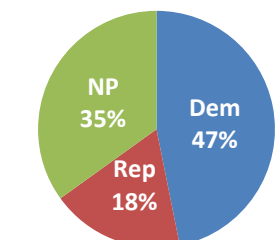
