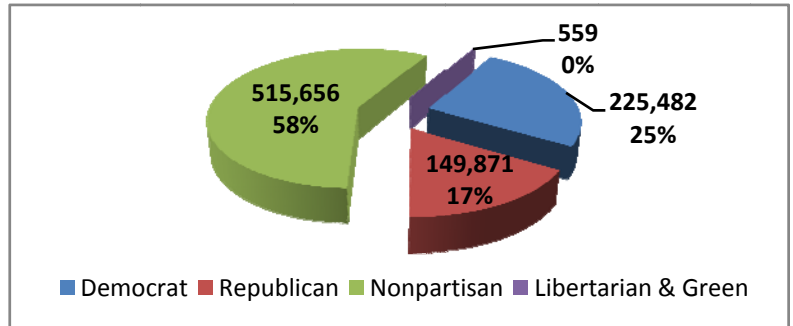

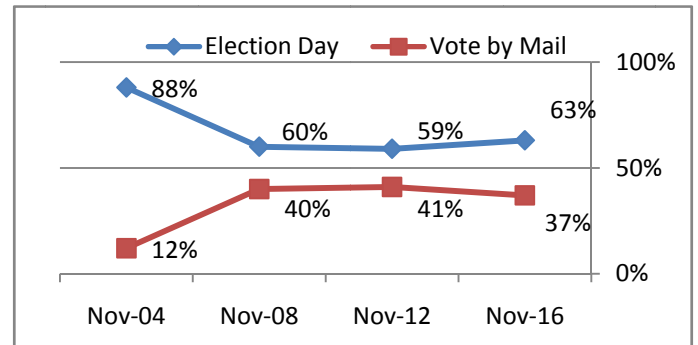
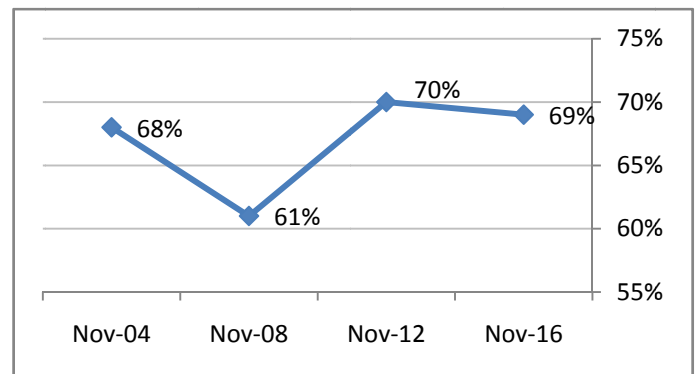

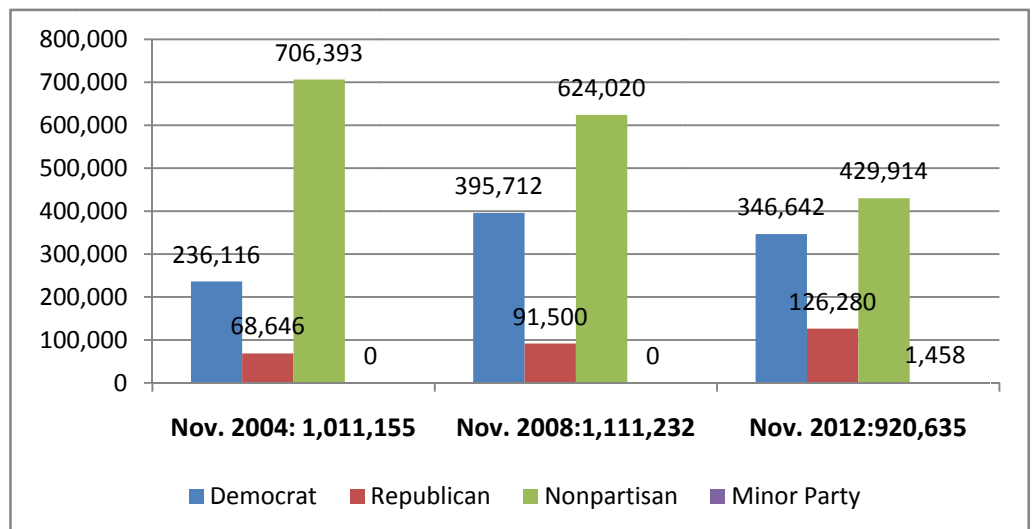
Current Voter Registration Statistics by Political Party
