













# **Registered voters by Political Party in May Elections**

## **Ballot Details**

**7 statewide offices:** Governor, Attorney General, Auditor, Secretary of State Treasurer, State Supreme Court (2)

4 Federal: US Congress Dist 9, 11, 14 and 16
14 State: State Senate Dist 21, 23 and 25

**11 State House:** State House Dist 6, 7, 8, 9, 10, 11, 12, 13, 14, 15 and 16

**7 County:** County Executive and 6 County Council seats, odd numbered: Dist 1, 3, 5, 7, 9, and 11

**19 County:** Judicial seats

18 State Central Committee seats: Democratic, Republican and Green party State Central Committee seats
