Official Election Results for the September 23, 2014 Recall Election are attached in the Election Summary Report.


SUMMARY OF OFFICIAL CANVASS

There were a total of 2,780 ballots tabulated for the September 23, 2014 Election. Below is a breakdown of the ballots counted by category and a percentage of the total vote by category.

ABSENTEE / VOTE BY MAIL

The Cuyahoga County Board of Elections received a total of 330 valid Absentee/Vote by Mail applications. Of those requests, 300 ballots were returned (90.9%). The Ballot Department tabulated 292 Absentee / Vote by Mail Ballots of the applications processed. There were 8 ballots challenged in this election resulting in a challenge rate of 2.67%*. Details of the challenges are below.


*The Absentee Ballot Challenge Rate is 1.68% when the Absentee Ballots postmarked after the deadline are excluded.

PROVISIONAL VOTING SUMMARY

A total of 51 Provisional Ballots were cast In-House and on Election Day. Of those ballots, 39 (76.47%) were valid and tabulated by the Ballot Department. There were 12 invalid Provisional Ballots resulting in a 23.53%* rejection rate for this election. Details of the rejections are below.



BALLOT REMAKES

During the election, 3 ballot pages were processed in accordance with the CCBOE Remake Policy (approved by the Board on May 17, 2013). Of those, 1 was processed during the Unofficial Canvass. The remaining 2 ballot pages were processed during the Official Canvass. The following is a breakdown by category:

AUDIT

The date of the post-election audit will be determined following the November 2014 General Election. This audit will be conducted using the precinct batch based risk limiting audit method. If a requested recount is required, the recount will be performed instead of the audit.
