Lawful appointing authorities may appoint one observer to a Post-Election Audit. The Notice of Appointment must be filed with the Board of Elections not later than five days after the Board of Elections gives notice of the date and time of the post-election audit.

Any Notice of Amendment to the original appointment must be filed by the day before the post-election audit.
