OFFICIAL QUESTIONS AND ISSUES BALLOT

STATE ISSUE

Proposed Constitutional Amendment – Issue One –

To amend the version of Section 1 of Article XI that is scheduled to take effect January 1, 2021, and to enact Sections 1, 2, and 3 of Article XIX of the Constitution of the State of Ohio to establish a process for congressional redistricting.

SCHOOL/SPECIAL DISTRICT ISSUES

Beachwood City School District

Proposed Bond Issue and Tax Levy

Shall the Beachwood City School District be authorized to do the following:

(1) Issue bonds for the purpose of constructing, renovating, remodeling, adding to, furnishing, equipping and otherwise improving school district buildings and facilities, including a consolidated elementary school, and clearing and improving their sites in the principal amount of \$39,000,000, to be repaid annually over a maximum of 35 years, and levy a property tax outside the ten-mill limitation, estimated by the County Fiscal Officer to average over the bond repayment period 2.8 mills for each one dollar of tax valuation, which amounts to 28 cents for each one hundred dollars of tax valuation, to pay the annual debt charges on the bonds, and to pay debt charges on any notes issued in anticipation of those bonds?

(2) Levy an additional property tax to pay current operating expenses at a rate not exceeding 5.9 mills for each one dollar of tax valuation, which amounts to 59 cents for each one hundred dollars of tax valuation, for a continuing period of time?

Brecksville – Broadview Heights City School District

Proposed Bond Issue

Shall bonds be issued by the Brecksville – Broadview Heights City School District for the purpose of constructing, furnishing, equipping and otherwise improving a new elementary school, renovating, remodeling, adding to, furnishing, equipping and otherwise improving existing School District buildings and facilities and acquiring, clearing, improving and equipping real estate for School District buildings and facilities in the principal amount of \$44,500,000, to be repaid annually over a maximum period of 35 years, and an annual levy of property taxes be made outside of the ten-mill limitation, estimated by the County Fiscal Officer to average over the repayment period of the bond issue 2.2 mills for each one dollar of tax valuation, which amounts to 22 cents for each one hundred dollars of tax valuation, commencing in 2018, first due in calendar year 2019, to pay the annual debt charges on the bonds, and to pay debt charges on any notes issued in anticipation of those bonds?

Brooklyn City School District

Proposed Tax Levy (Renewal) - 7.5 mills for the purpose of avoiding an operating deficit in the sum of \$2,254,000 for a period of five years.

Parma City School District

Proposed Tax Levy (Additional) - 7.4 mills for the purpose of providing for the emergency requirements of this district in the sum of \$14,724,327 for a period of ten years.

Porter Public Library

Proposed Tax Levy (Renewal) - 2.8 mills for the purpose of current expenses for a period of five years.

Shaker Heights Public Library

Proposed Tax Levy (Additional) - 1.9 mills for the purpose of current expenses for a continuing period of time.

Solon City School District

Proposed Tax Levies (Additional) - for the purpose current expenses, the aggregate rate of which may increase in one increment of not more than 6.9 mills, from an original rate of 1.6 mills, to a maximum rate of 8.5 mills. The original tax is first proposed to be levied in 2018, and the incremental tax in 2019. The aggregate rate of tax so authorized will be in effect for a continuing period of time.

COUNTY ISSUE

County of Cuyahoga

Proposed Tax Levy Health and Human Services (Renewal) – 3.9 mills for the purpose of supplementing general fund appropriations for health and human or social services for a period of two years.

MUNICIPAL ISSUES

Village of Brooklyn Heights

Proposed Municipal Income Tax (Increase) -providing for a 0.5% levy increase on income, to a rate of 2.5% levy on income per annum, for the purpose of continuing general municipal functions, effective July 1, 2018.

City of Cleveland Ward 8 Precinct D

Local Liquor Option (Sunday Sales) - Permitting the sale of beer, wine and mixed beverages for sale on Sunday between 10 a.m. and midnight by Lucky Times LLC dba Freeway Sunoco, at 15504 Waterloo Road and gas pumps, Cleveland, OH 44110.

City of North Olmsted

Proposed Bond Issue - Shall bonds be issued by the City of North Olmsted for the purpose of improving the City's park and recreational facilities by constructing, renovating, remodeling, adding to, furnishing, equipping and otherwise improving facilities for aquatics, basketball, volleyball, ice skating, fitness, indoor and outdoor walking and gymnastics, ball fields, public spaces, locker rooms and spaces for related and supporting activities at the Recreation Center complex; improving North Olmsted Community Park by constructing, furnishing, equipping and otherwise improving a new football and soccer field, a band shell and performance stage, an all-purpose trail, playgrounds, bocce courts, parking areas and related supporting facilities and improving existing ball fields, restrooms and other facilities; and improving Barton and Bradley Park by improving existing facilities and providing supporting site, street and sidewalk improvements, in each case together with the necessary appurtenances and work incidental thereto in the principal amount of \$44,800,000, to be repaid annually over a maximum period of 24 years, and an annual levy of property taxes be made outside of the 11.1-mill charter tax rate limitation, estimated by the County Fiscal Officer to average over the repayment period of the bond issue 3.6 mills for each one dollar of tax valuation, which amounts to 36 cents for each one hundred dollars of tax valuation, commencing in 2018, first due in calendar year 2019, to pay the annual debt charges on any notes issued in anticipation of those bonds?

City of North Royalton

Proposed Zoning Amendment - Shall the Zoning Map of the City of North Royalton be amended to change the classification of PP#'s 489-02-005 and 489-03-019 (parcels with frontage on Sprague Road and State Road contiguous to 8217 Ridgedale Drive) from their current Residential (R1A) classification to the Senior Citizen District (SCD) classification?

City of Solon

Proposed Zoning Amendment - Shall the Zoning Map of the City of Solon be amended to change the zoning classification of PP#'s 952-19-005, 952-19-006, 952-19-007, 952-19-008, 952-19-009 and 952-19-013, comprising approximately 5.38 acres located to the east of the intersection of Kruse Drive and Bainbridge Road, from the current C-1 Historic Commercial District and C-2 Restricted Commercial District to R-3-A Senior Citizen Residential-1 Zoning District?

City of Westlake Ward 4 Precinct D

Local Liquor Option (Sunday Sales) - Permitting the sale of wine and mixed beverages for sale on Sunday between 10 a.m. and midnight by Ganesha Food Inc dba Convenient Food Mart at 29233 Center Ridge Road, Westlake, OH 44145.
