### **IMPORTANT DEADLINES ARE APPROACHING FOR VOTERS IN THE MAY 7, 2019 PRIMARY ELECTION**

(Cleveland) – Extended early voting hours and weekend voting are available for people who live in the 11 cities that are holding Elections on May 7th. The Board is open for early voting:

Weekdays from April 29 until May 3	8:00 AM to 7:00 PM
Saturday, May 04	8:00 AM to 4:00 PM
Sunday, May 05	1:00 PM to 5:00 PM
Monday, May 06	8:00 AM to 2:00 PM

The Board of Elections is located at 2925 Euclid Avenue, Cleveland.

The Board of Elections is also reminding people to return their vote-by-mail ballots. “There are still thousands of people who have yet to return their ballots and we are just days away from the Election,” said Tony Perlatti, Director of the Board of Elections. Voters need to know that their ballots must be postmarked on or before May 6th. “It is very important to get them to the post office as soon as possible to avoid missing the deadline,” said Perlatti.

Ballots may also be dropped off at the Board until 7:30 p.m. on Election Day. There is a drive through ballot box at the rear of the Board building that is available 24/7. Ballots cannot be dropped off at a polling location on Election Day.
