### **VOTING TO BEGIN IN THE SEPTEMBER 10, 2019 PRIMARY ELECTION**

(Cleveland) – The Cuyahoga County Board of Elections is reminding people that Elections are being held in six municipalities on September 10, 2019.

Early voting at the Board of Elections gets underway on August 13th. This is also the day the Board of Elections will begin mailing ballots to voters who have submitted vote by mail applications. “Voting by mail and early voting are excellent options for casting ballots in this type of Election,” said Tony Perlatti, Director of the Board of Elections. “Most people only think about voting in May and November so it is important to make a plan to vote that can include a trip to the Board or by requesting a vote by mail ballot,” said Perlatti.
