### THE CUYAHOGA COUNTY BOARD OF ELECTIONS AND THE ROCK AND ROLL HALL OF FAME TO WORK IN CONCERT TO REGISTER AND EDUCATE VOTERS

(Cleveland) The Board of Elections is partnering with the Rock and Roll Hall of Fame to educate voters and will be onsite during the Resident Rockers Showcase of the Live and Local Series of free concerts at the Rock and Roll Hall of Fame that combines music and voter education.
