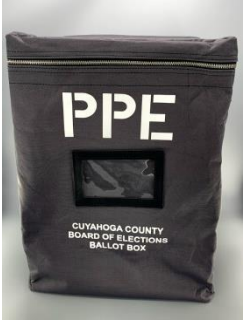


PPE | SANITATION SUPPLY BAG



PPE | Sanitation Supplies will be found in the large Gray Bag labeled **PPE**. Larger locations will receive more than one bag.

PPE | SANITATION SUPPLY BAG CONTENTS AND USE



Digital Thermometer – The Voting Location Manager should assign a PEO to take the temperature of each worker. The maximum temperature is 100.3 degrees Fahrenheit. There will be no temperature checks for voters.



Face Masks – For workers or voters who did not bring his/her own mask.



Finger Cots and Tissues – Each voter should use a finger cot or a tissue to cover his/her finger when signing the Electronic Pollbook.



Alcohol Spray Bottles – For sanitizing Voting Booths and frequently touched surfaces.

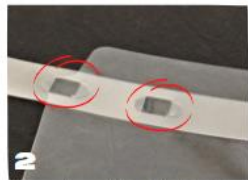


Safety Glasses - Provided for workers to use for additional eye protection.

Face Shields (Disposable) – Provided for Workers who would like additional coverage to the front and side of the face.



1 Align plastic head strap and clear shield.



2 Insert and lock left-side clear shield tabs into left side locking holes. *Do not bend tabs!*



3 Slightly bend the shield so the right side tabs line up with right side holes and can be inserted.



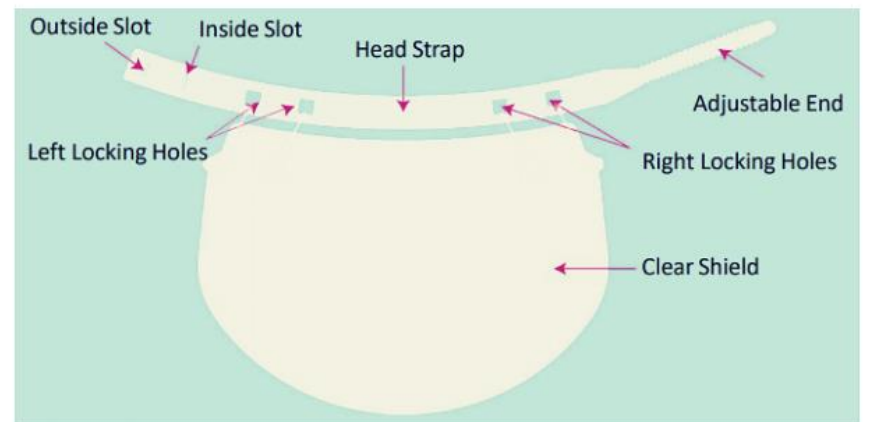
4 Insert the adjustable end of the band into the slot on the back of the shield.



5 Estimate the correct size, and insert the adjustable end into the inside slot.



6 Assembly is now complete. The face shield is ready to wear.



Alcohol Swabs – Used to wipe Electronic Pollbooks and DS200s as needed.



Gloves – For use when cleaning and disinfecting surfaces throughout the Polling Location.













Hand Sanitizer – For use when soap and water are not available to sanitize hands.




Hand Soap – Additional hand soap to use as back up lavatory soap. Wash hands frequently throughout the day.

	<p>Paper Bags – To place on the check-in table for voters to dispose of finger cots and tissue.</p>		<p>Measuring Rope – Rope cut to 6-foot length for measuring distance between voting booths and equipment.</p>
	<p>Safety Vests – YELLOW for Sanitation Official. ORANGE for Voter Greeter.</p>		<p>Ponchos – For Workers that must go outside to assist Curbside Voters.</p>
	<p>Pen Cup – To hold clean pens.</p>		<p>Finger Cot bowl – To be placed on the check-in tables for voters to cover their finger when signing the EPBs.</p>
	<p>Social Distance Marker – Placed on the floor, 6 feet apart, in areas where voters will form lines (Check-in, DS200 scanner).</p>		<p>Door Stops – To decrease amount of door handles that need to be touched.</p>
	<p>Trash Can & Trash Can Liners – Provided to allow poll workers the ability to easily dispose of trash</p>		<p>Disposable Gown – Provided for additional protection for workers encountering a voter with symptoms of illness.</p>
